

Recycle your Electronics Responsibly

SARCAN collects end-of-life electronics for responsible recycling at all of its depots on behalf of the Electronic Products Recycling Association (EPRA).

EPRA, a non-profit association created by electronics manufacturers and retailers, manages the program in accordance with the Province of Saskatchewan's Environmental Management and Protection Act. EPRA is funded by Environmental Handling Fees (EHFs) paid upon the purchase of new electronics.

What Happens to Electronics?

The electronics dropped off at SARCAN depots are expressly done so for the purposes of dismantling and recycling (not reuse or resale). It is because of this that SARCAN depots are not able to offer any electronics or components of electronics to the public for reuse or resale.

Data Security

Electronics collected by SARCAN Recycling are not plugged in or operated. Concerned customers are still encouraged to wipe their personal information from any data-containing electronics (including, but not limited to, CPUs, laptops, desktop servers, fax machines, answering machines, cell phones and cameras). The fully secure dismantling sites that dismantle and recycle the electronics collected under EPRA must meet rigid security standards that prevent the unlawful access of customer information.

A Part of Your Community

All 73 SARCAN Recycling depots across Saskatchewan accept end-of-life electronics. Visit sarcan.ca to find the location nearest you and find out their hours of operation.

Do You Have a Mountain of Electronics?

Customers may bring in up to 25 large pieces of electronics per depot per day without making an appointment.

Large volume generators of electronics and other bulk electronics customers may drop off more than this by appointment only. Please contact the depot in your community by phone to book an appointment.

Recycle Like a Pro:

- Do you only have electronics to recycle? Don't wait in line! Speak with our cashier to find out where you can drop off your electronics without standing in line.
- Do you have heavy electronics? While we cannot unload your vehicle for you, we want to make sure you are safe when you do so. To help save yourself from injury, consider bringing a friend or family member to help you unload your vehicle.

Accepted electronics:

- **Computers and Accessories:**

desktop computers, laptops, and tablets, as well as keyboards, mice, speakers, external modems/routers, external drives, and scanners.

- **Desktop Printers:**

printers designed to reside on a work surface, including: Inkjet, laser, dot matrix, all-in-one (multi-function) devices, photo printers, and label printers.

- **Photocopiers/Multi-Function Devices:**

including floor-standing models (with a maximum weight of 200 kilograms) and desktop models.

- **Fax Machines:**

- **Televisions and Other Display Devices:**

including CRT and flat panel televisions, video baby monitors, and e-book readers.

- **Audio Equipment:**

including stereos (home and automobile), speakers, headphones, microphones, portable music players (CD, cassette, MP3), voice recorders, radios, alarm clock radios, and turntables.

- **Video Equipment:**

including VCRs, DVD players, personal video recorders (PVRs), satellite and cable receivers, personal data assistants (PDAs), digital picture frames, and GPS systems.

- **Video Game Systems:**

including game consoles and accessories.

- **Cameras:**

including film, digital, video, web, and security cameras.

- **Telephones:**

including corded and cordless telephones, cellular and smart phones, pagers, beepers, and answering machines.

- **Microwave Ovens:**

Counter-top models only.



Not accepted products:

- **Small Household Appliances:**

including coffee makers, blenders, vacuums, and toasters.

- **Large Appliances:**

including ovens, refrigerators, and dishwashers.

- **Personal Care Appliances:**

including razors, hair dryers, and electric toothbrushes.

- **Lamps and Light Bulbs**

- **Fans, Heaters, and Air Conditioners**

- **Power Tools:**

including saws, drills, and lawn mowers.

- **Musical Equipment:**

including guitars, music keyboards, and amps.

- **Medical Devices**
